

Employers are continuing to reward poor performance by managers, according to the 2015 National Management Salary Survey from the Chartered Management Institute (CMI) and XpertHR.








## SALARIES ARE RISING ABOVE INFLATION



Overall, managers' salaries are rising ahead of inflation.









# LABOUR TURNOVER HAS INCREASED



Labour turnover has more than doubled since last year.









